The first hour of the first class is a parent / student orientation- parent or legal guardian must attend class for this hour.
10 days prior to the start of the class, the student may go to any Dept. of Licensing office to have a Learner Permit issued. *

To obtain a Learner permit earlier, student must be 15 1/2 years old* and pass the WA State Dept. of Licensing Knowledge test.* *WA State Laws
